

GREC'S ACTIVITIES: PREVENTING AND RESPONDING TO RACIST INCIDENTS

Teamwork Against Racist Crime - TARC

Objectives 2005-06

- Record racist incidents reported in Grampian and in Highland, and to report the results to various agencies through the three local authority Racist Incident Partnerships and the Highland Alliance for Racial Equality
- Begin development of custom-built racist incident monitoring database

Achieved during the year

- 459 incidents were reported to the various partner agencies, and recorded on Racist Incident Monitoring Forms which were then forwarded to GREC for input into the racist incident monitoring database
- There was an 8% increase in reporting of racist incidents over 2004-05
- 10 meetings of the Racist Incident Partnerships were attended, with statistical reports produced for each
- 4 meetings of HARE were attended, with statistical reports produced for each
- In addition, there were requests throughout the year for reports on specific aspects of the racist incident statistics

Objectives for 2006-07

- Complete development of custom-built racist incident monitoring database
- Promote use of database to other agencies throughout Scotland
